

2021 SUPPLY LIST: RISING SIXTH GRADERS

Below are the supplies students will need for sixth grade. Teachers may ask for additional supplies throughout the year. You may wish to wait to purchase these items until you find out which teachers you will have. Please put student's first and last name on individual supplies.

- Loose-leaf, college ruled paper
- Pencils
- 3-ring binder with dividers (Binder should be able to fit in student's locker.)
- 8 composition notebooks (2 of the 8 should be graph paper; the rest lined.)
- 1 folder with pockets for SS *(Parsons' class' folder and comp book numbers differ.)
- Post-It flags/Post-It notes (Post-its will be used throughout the year.)
- Colored pencils and markers
- Highlighters- 4 different colors
