It's natural for middle schoolers to want to fit in with their peers—and hard when they feel like they don't. Use these tips to help your child handle worries.

- **Right-size the problem.** Not being part of the "in crowd" can seem like the end of the world to your tween. Acknowledge their feelings ("It must be tough to feel left out").
- Take small steps. If your middle grader longs to join a group of kids, suggest making one
 friend at a time instead. It's easier to form a relationship with one person than a whole group.
 Or encourage them to create their own circle of like-minded people by joining a club or taking
 part in other group activities that interest them.




- Cost \$6.00 and tickets must be purchased through Go Fan at <u>Meigs Academic Magnet Middle</u> <u>School Events and Tickets by GoFan</u>
- Pick up Car rider line at the back of the building. All students will exit through the gym lobby doors. Students will not be allowed to walk to other parking lots. We must visibly see the parent/guardian picking the student up.
- Who May Attend Open only to current Meigs 5th, 6th, 7th, and 8th grade students
- **Dress** –Normal dress code will apply. Clothing determined inappropriate due to safety, too revealing, or vulgar / inappropriate topics will not be allowed.
- Cell Phones Cell phones will not be allowed during the dance, neither in the gymnasium or concession area.

5th/6th grade - Phones will remain in backpacks until students leave the dance.

7th/8th grade – Phones will be collected as students check-in and housed in a safe, locked area by staff members. Phones will be picked up by students at the end of the dance.
