Ways to practice gratitude

Inspire your student to appreciate the good things in life. They'll feel happier and more optimistic with these projects.

Springtime gratitude tree: Ask your child to fill a large glass jar halfway with rocks, then insert twigs to make a "tree." Next, have your child draw and cut out construction paper "leaves." They could write something they're grateful for on each leaf, then poke a hole in the leaf and hang it on the tree. Idea: Encourage your child to keep a pile of blank leaves nearby so family members can fill in their own "gratitude leaves."

The ABCs of thankfulness: Give your child a stack of index cards and a challenge: Write at least one thing they're grateful for each day, starting with A ("Apple pie for dessert") and ending with Z ("Zero trouble with my history test"). They can hole-punch the cards and keep them on a ring.

SEL for parents:

"You may not feel like you have much influence on your child these days, but teens' behavior is highly correlated with the strength of their bonds with their parents. Good relationships between teenagers and their parents, as rated by both, are positively correlated with school success and general happiness as rated by the teen, and also by those around her. By contrast, weak or conflictual parent/teen relationships are correlated with early sexual activity, experimentation with drugs and alcohol, the teen's involvement in violence (as either perpetrator or victim), and suicide. How do you parent this blossoming person who sometimes seems to be becoming a stranger?"




